During this 90 minute audio conference, Dr. Michael Policar will provide an update on recently available contraceptive methods, share information about contraceptives on the horizon, review current dosing and timing for emergency contraception and discuss contraceptives that are used for non-contraceptive purposes. - Describe 3 management points regarding fracture risk in women using DMPA
- Give 3 rules for the use of the "Quick Start" regimen in initiating hormonal contraceptives
- List 3 advantages and 3 disadvantages of etonogestrel implants (Implanon)

Fees
